## **RIGHT-OF-WAY BOND**

### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, <u>Basin Electric Power Cooperative</u>, Inc., hereinafter called the Principal, and <u>Travelers Casualty and Surety</u> <u>Company of America</u>, as Surety, are jointly and severally held and firmly bound unto the <u>South Dakota Public Utilities</u> <u>Commission</u>, hereinafter called the <u>Obligee</u>, on behalf of and for the benefit for all townships, counties, and other governmental entities whose properties are crossed by the natural gas pipeline facilities described in <u>Stipulation HP09-002</u>, in the sum of <u>One Million Three Hundred Thousand And No/100 Dollars</u> (\$1,300,000.00 ) lawful money of the United States of America, for the payment of which sum we bind ourselves and our successors, heirs, administrators or personal representatives as the case may be.

WHEREAS, Principal has applied or will apply to the Obligee for a permit, permits, or permission to do work within the Right-of-Way of townships, counties, and other governmental entities whose properties are crossed by the natural gas pipeline facilities described in Stipulation HP09-002,

WHEREAS, South Dakota Codified Law 49-41B-38 requires any person performing any construction or survey work to furnish an indemnity bond in a reasonable amount that runs in favor of, and for the benefit of, such townships, counties, or other governmental entities whose property is crossed by a transmission facility insuring that any damage beyond normal wear to public roads, highways, bridges, or other related facilities shall be adequately compensated,

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall restore all pre-existing roads and lanes used during the construction of the transmission facilities to at least their pre-construction condition as described in accordance with Stipulation EL09-015 then this obligation is null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

This obligation may be canceled by the Surety by its giving thirty (30) days written notice to the Principal and Obligee. Regardless of the length of time that this bond remains in force, in no event shall the Surety's obligation exceed the sum listed above.
