Weather and roadway conditions restricted inspections along Spread 6 during this reporting period. Disturbed areas along the right-of-way continue to remain stabilized. Site work (rock, electrical, access road construction, fencing, etc.) continues at numerous valve and launcher/receiver sites. Freezing and thawing cycles were more evident during this reporting period; however, no significant issues were observed along the right-of-way.
