Snow accumulation along the right-of-way decreased considerably during this reporting period. While subsoils remained frozen, the top 8 inches of topsoil was predominantly saturated across all Spreads. Minor rill erosion was observed at isolated locations. However, no significant problem areas were recorded. Fencing and minor site work continues at numerous valve and launcher/receiver sites. As shown in Sections II and III, there were no Non-Compliance, Problem Areas, or Violations recorded.
