South Dakota Intrastate Pipeline Company, the Applicant above named, hereby moves the Public Utilities Commission for an Order clarifying or amending its Order Granting Construction Permit.

The purpose of this Motion is to clarify and/or amend Paragraph 18 in Appendix II of the Terms and Conditions for a Permit in Docket NG92-002 which is attached to and incorporated in the Order Granting Construction Permit. Clarification of this provision is necessary in order to more clearly define the actual depth at which the pipeline is to be buried within the various road ditches in compliance with Paragraph 13 of the Findings of Fact attached to and incorporated in the Order Granting Construction Permit.


Pursuant to Paragraph 13 of the Findings of Fact, the pipe should be buried a minimum depth of 36 inches wherever it lies. That is, that wherever within the ditch the pipe is situated, it will be covered with a minimum of 36 inches of cover. In other words, the depth of the pipe will be determined exactly from where the pipe is lying rather than some artificial measuring point such as the toe of the ditch slope.

As testimony in the hearing on SDIPC's Motion to Reopen Siting Application, any depth which the pipeline is buried beyond 36 inches will add additional and unnecessary cost to the construction of the pipeline, cost which will be ultimately passed on to natural gas

consumers.

In the alternative to the above referenced clarification, SDIPC hereby requests an Amended Order Granting Construction Permit indicating that the pipeline shall be buried a minimum of 36 inches, with such depth being measured from the specific area within the ditch in which the pipeline is buried.


