With this filing, MidAmerican Energy Company (Company) proposes to update the back of its standard bill form, Section VI, Sheet No. 3. The following changes are proposed:

- The customer service Internet address has been provided;
- The customer service e-mail address has been omitted, but can be obtained from the customer service Web site;
- The parenthetical reference to "TDD" has been eliminated under the assumption that customers using Telecommunications Devices for the Deaf know what the abbreviation "TDD" represents;

MidAmerican Energy Company submits, for approval, an original and eleven (11) copies of the filing and attached tariff sheet:


SD P.U.C. Section VI, Third Revised Sheet No. 3.56 cancels SD P.U.C. Section VI, Second Revised Sheet No. 3.

On August 10, 2000, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) requesting approval of a revision to its South Dakota Gas Sales Tariff. According to the filing, MidAmerican proposes to update the back of its standard bill form, Section VI, Sheet No. 3. MidAmerican requested that the proposed tariff changes be made effective September 12, 2000. The revised tariff is as follows:

SDPUC Gas Sales Tariff

Section No. VI, 3rd Revised Sheet No. 3, Cancelling 2nd Revised Sheet No. 3

At its regularly scheduled meeting of September 13, 2000, the Commission discussed final approval of the application. Commission Staff recommended approval of the revisions to the bill format tariff sheet.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-2, 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, and 49-34A-10 and ARSD 20:10:17:03. The Commission finds the bill format changes to the customers' bills are just and reasonable and approved the changes. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the above-referenced revised tariff schedule is approved and is effective for service rendered on and after the date of this order.
