- 1. The Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 (EISA of 2007) was signed into law on December 19, 2007. The EISA of 2007 amends Section 303(b) of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (PURPA) to include new natural gas standards.
- 2. At the request of Public Utilities Commission Staff, the Commission has opened the above-captioned docket to research and consider the new standards to determine whether they should be implemented in South Dakota.
- 3. As an investor-owned, rate-regulated public utility serving natural gas customers in South Dakota, NorthWestern Energy as an affected party is subject to the new PURPA standards under the EISA of 2007. NorthWestern Energy requests intervention in order to participate fully in this matter.
- 4. The interests of NorthWestern Energy are unique and cannot be fully and adequately represented by the existing parties. NorthWestern Energy and its stakeholders and ratepayers may be directly affected by the issues raised in this proceeding and its outcome.

WHEREFORE, NorthWestern Energy respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Petition granting it party status in this proceeding.
