On March 28, 2024, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from NorthWestern Corporation dba NorthWestern Energy (NorthWestern) for Approval of its 2024 Economic Development Plan and 2023 Economic Development Report.

On April 4, 2024, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of April 19, 2024, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed. On April 26, 2024, NorthWestern filed a Revised Attachment B.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically, SDCL 49-34A-4 and 49-34A-6.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on May 8, 2024, the Commission considered this matter. Commission Staff recommended approval. After review of the report and plan, the Commission found the activities and contributions set forth therein to be just and reasonable and voted unanimously to approve NorthWestern's 2024 Economic Development Plan and the 2023 Economic Development Report. It is therefore

ORDERED, that NorthWestern's 2024 Economic Development Plan and 2023 Economic Development Report are hereby approved as filed.
