### TARIFF WITH TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

The existing long distance Tariff of Tele-Tech, Inc. is on file with the South Dakota Public Utility Commission. The Tariff for local exchange services, together with terms and conditions of service, are dependent upon the outcome of negotiations with the incumbent local exchange carriers. Accordingly, some of the specific and detailed information requested by this subdivision remains subject to negotiation or arbitration with the local exchange carriers. Applicant therefore requests waiver of this provision pending the outcome of said negotiation or arbitration.

Appropriate and complete Tariff's will be filed with the Commission upon completion of negotiation with the local exchange carriers.

### SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION AND OVERVIEW

Tele-Tech. Inc. has ten (10) full time and four (4) part time employees in its Sioux Falls. SD location.

Tele-Tech intends to enter local service on a resale basis. The calling areas of that service will be in the U. S. West exchanges. Tele-Tech will service all customers in those areas as required by law. In the future, if Tele-Tech should chose to serve customers in the rural markets, Tele-Tech will negotiate with those rural earriers, all as presembed by the Federal Act. Regulations and Rules and Orders of the Commission.

Tele Tech, Inc. has been in business since October 2, 1984. It's primary switch is fully redundant with an uninterrupted power supply and generator backup system.

The Tele-Tech base of operations in Sioux Falls, South Dakota is staffed 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and full time service personnel are on duty or on call 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, to respond to trouble reports. In house personnel is also factory trained and certified in the maintenance and servicing of the switch and all other operating equipment

Assistance with all produ : or billing inquires, changes in service or additions to services will be handled during regular business hours. Tele-Tech's goal is to respond to calls within one (1) hour and to resolve any issues within four (4) hours. If a customer is unsatisfied with the level of service provided by the customer service consultant, the call will be transferred to a supervisor. Tele-Tech currently provides inter-connect customers with immediate call response and will provide on site technical staff within one (1) hour or as travel time permits.

Customers will be switched to Tele-Tech, Inc. upon a written letter of authorization (L.O.A.) The switching will be handled in a professional and expeditious manner. Tele-Tech will only switch customers requesting Tele-Tech as a service provider. Tele-Tech has not and will not engage in the practice of slamming in order to obtain customers. If for any reason a customer is switched to Tele-Tech in error, he will be returned to his prior provider at no expense to the customer.

Number portability will be provided, dependent upon the outcome of negotiations with the incumbent local exchange carrier, and consistent with the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.

It is required that all numbers be listed in a directory. US West, as the incumbent local exchange service is obligated to provide the directory and include all numbers of all customers in a calling area. In the event that Tele-Tech, Inc. elects to publish its own directory, all customers in the calling area will be included in that directory.

Directory assistance will be provided as a pass through service from U.S. West Communications, Inc.

Surcharges for 911 and the hearing impaired will be collected and remitted to the proper agencies as required by Statute, Ordinance or Regulation.

Tele-Tech, Inc. will provide all new customers with a packet of information, explaining how to read their bill, how to pay their bill and where to call with questions.

The manner in which Tele-Tech will market its services, will be dependent upon the outcome of negotiations with U.S. West Communications, line, at which time the specific services and the rates for specific services will be identified. Tele-Tech will not enter into joint marketing with U.S. West.

ORDER GRANTING AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY TC97-011

On February 5, 1997, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission), in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD 20.10.24.02, received an application for an Amended Certificate of Authority from Tele-Tech. Inc. (Tele-Tech).

Tele-Tech proposes to amend its Certificate of Authority so that it may offer local acknange service in addition to its offering of interexchange carrier access and other telecommunications services. Tele-Tech does not intend to offer any local service in areas presently served by independent rural telecommunications companies, unless designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 214(e)(1) and 253(f), and then only upon approval by the Commission of any required interconnection agreement as prescribed by 47 U.S.C. § 252 of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996

On February 13, 1997, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of February 28, 1997, to interested individuals and entities. No parties filed to intervene. At its regularly scheduled meeting of May 13, 1997, the Commission considered Tele-Tech's request for an Amended Certificate of Authority. Commission Staff recommended approval of the Amended Certificate of Authority. On June 3, 1997, the Commission considered the waiver of ARSD 20.10.24.02 (6), (7), (9), and (12), as requested by Tele-Tech in its filing.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and ARSD Chapter 2.0.10.24. The Commission finds that Tele-Tech has met the legal requirements established for the granting of an Amended Certificate of Authority. Tele-Tech has, in accordance with the above cited authority, demonstrated sufficient technical, financial and managerial capabilities to offer telecommunications services in South Dakota. Pursuant to ARSD 20.10.24.02, the Commission finds good cause to waive subparagraphs (6), (7), (9), and (12) because the information required by these subparagraphs is dependent on the outcome of negotiations or arbitrations between Tele-Tech and local exchange carriers.

Further, the Commission finds that pursuant to Tele-Tech's request, the Amended Certificate of Authority for Tele-Tech shall authorize it to offer its services in those areas in South Dakota where U S WEST Communications, Inc. is the incumbent local exchange carrier. In the future should Tele-Tech choose to provide services statewide, with respect to rural telephone companies. Tele-Tech will have to come before the Commission in another proceeding before being able to provide service in that rural service area pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 253(f) which allows the Commission to require a company that seeks to provide service in a rural service area to meet the requirements in 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(1) for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier. In addition, the granting of

statewide certification will not affect the exemptions, suspensions, and modifications for rural telephone companies found in 47 U.S.C. § 251(f). Subject to the above, the Commission approves Tele-Tech's application for an Amended Certificate of Authority. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that Tele-Tech's application for an Amended Certificate of Authority to provide local exchange services is granted, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Commission shall authorize Tele-Tech to offer its services in those areas in South Dakota where U S WEST Communications, Inc. is the incumbent local exchange carrier, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Commission finds good cause to waive subparagraphs (6), (7), (9), and (12) of ARSD 20.10.24.02
