RESOLUTION NO. 2-97

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings is authorized pursuant to South Dakota codified Law 9-4-1 to annex contiguous territory upon receipt of a written petition, describing said territory sought to be annexed, signed by not less than three-fourths (3/4) of the legal voters and by the owner or owners of not less than three-fourths (3/4) of the value of said territory, and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings desires to annex the following described property, to wit:

SE1/4 of Section 30-T110N-R49W, excluding Lot H-7, lying north and easterly of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad right-of-way

WHEREAS, the aforesaid land is contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Brookings, and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings has received a Petition for Annexation of Territory signed by the owners of greater than three-fourths (3/4) of the value of the aforesaid property and by all legal voters residing in said territory,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Brookings, South Dakota, that the property described above is hereby annexed to the City of Brookings

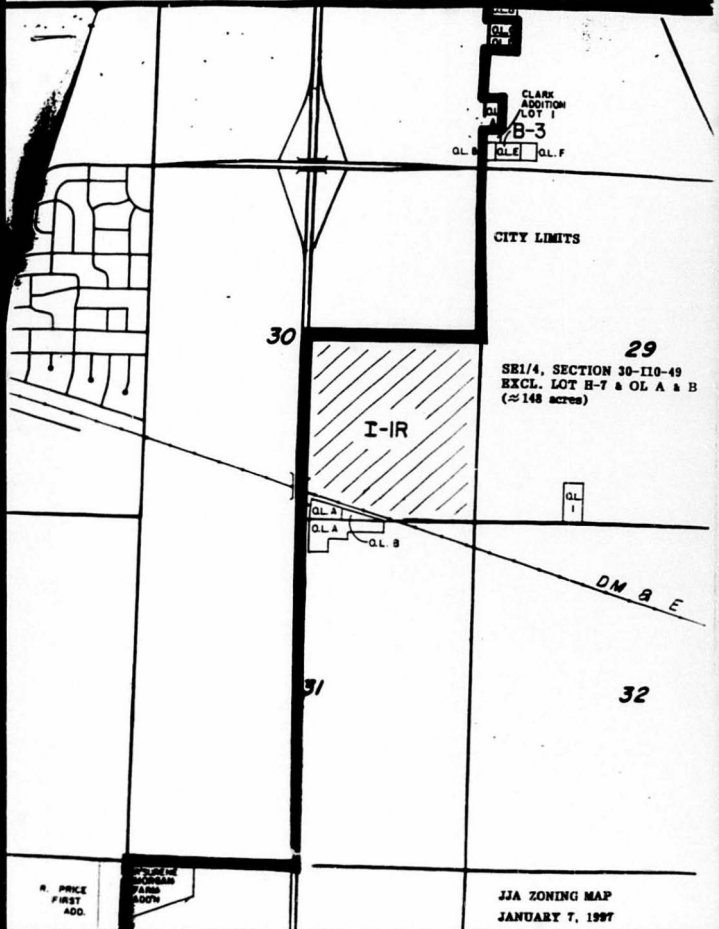

On January 29, 1997, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing by Brookings Telephone, City of Brookings (Brookings) to revise its franchise service territory map to reflect the new telephone service territory resulting from an annexation by the city of Brookings. The annexation described in Brookings City Resolution No. 2-97 consists of:

the SE1/4 of Section 30-T110N-R49W, excluding Outlots A and B.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31. No parties filed to intervene or comment by March 21, 1997. Upon review of the application to change the boundary to reflect areas annexed to the City of Brookings as described above, the Commission concludes that the proposed boundary change is in the public interest and should be approved. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore:

ORDERED that the proposed tariff revision reflecting the boundary change is hereby approved and is effective for telecommunications services rendered on and after April 1, 1997.
