The Commission found that pursuant to SDCL 49-31-12.6, LECA shall be assessed \$1,000 initially, subject to additional amounts as requested by the executive director up to the stat. tory limit. It is therefore

ORDERED that LECA deposit an initial assessment of \$1,000 in the SDPUC regulatory fee fund and shall deposit any additional amounts as requested by the executive director.
