On August 15, 1997, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint from Terry Nagel, Lead South Dakota, against U S West Communications, Inc. (U S West) regarding telephone service.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08:01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On September 9, 1997, at its duly noted meeting, the Commission deferred the complaint. On September 24, 1997, Commission Staff received word from Mr. Nagel that U S West had resolved all the issues raised in the complaint and Mr. Nagel requested that the complaint be dismissed and the docket closed.

On September 25, 1997, at its regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission reviewed this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-13-1, 49-13-4, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, and ARSD 20:10:01:07.01 and 20:10:01:08.01. As Mr. Nagel and U S West had resolved all the issues complained of by Mr. Nagel and he had requested dismissal and closure of the docket, Commission Staff recommended that the Commission close the docket.

ORDERED, that this complaint be dismissed and the docket closed.
