James Van't Land has made countless calls to US WEST trying to get the 3 lines installed that were requested late March or early April. They were given the following three numbers to publish to family and business contacts Home #578-7798, Office #578-9723, and fax #578-9741. These arrangements were made while still living in Malaysia and it was understood that the lines would be operational June 22, 1998. Upon arrival on that date, they were told that no cable pairs were available and that there was no guarantee that he could have telephone until November this year. The Van't Lands were also told that after an 8-day waiting period, they would be given one cell phone to handle personal communication needs (605) 390-9152. Meanwhile, the original numbers ring with a message that all circuits are busy or, most recently, that the number has been disconnected and no forwarding information to the cell phone is given. Royal (Mac) McCrackin, a US West contact in Rapid City was called on Monday July 6" by myself, Denise Broveak, and asked when the Van't Lands could expect their phone lines. He talked to an engineer that indicated it could be possible to have something to them by July 10th and that other lines may be available sometime after the end of August.

James and Hollie Van't Land have suffered a great deal of stress from this ordeal. There was enough stress in moving the family back to the United States after 11 years of living in Asia. Many family and business contacts have been greatly anticipating their return and were issued the phone numbers early on. No one has been able to reach them in a normal fashion. And no comfort or cooperation has come from US West.

I anticipate a repeat problem shortly with other new arrivals unless I can be sure that telephone service is made available soon.

Dear Mr. Bullard:

The purpose of this letter is to advise the Commission as to the anticipated completion date of above construction projects and to request that the Commission extend the completion date of the Hofer project accordingly.

U S WEST is currently concentrating on a backlog of repair and installation jobs which occurred as a result of the work stoppage involving U S WEST occupational employees. U S WEST nevertheless anticipates completing the Hofer project by the end of this month and requests that the Commission enter an order establishing a September 30th completion date.

Due to the work stoppage and recovery therefrom, U S WEST does not know whether it be able to complete the Mina Lake project by October 31st. We are working as expeditiously as possible on the Mina Lake project and will keep the Commission advised as to the completion of major project milestones.

ORDER DISMISSING
COMPLAINT AND CLOSING

On July 8, 1998, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint from Denise Broveak against U S WEST communications, Inc. (U S WEST) regarding additional lines that the Elik Ridge Home Owners Association felt were needed in its subdivision. Ms. Broveak requested the following relief: "U S WEST has known for several years of this problem and have done nothing to prepare. Now, the Van't Lands are suffering from their lack of telephone access. Another family will soon be moving here (also needing a business line) and they are out of luck also. We need a multiplexer or more cable! Van't Lands deserve compensation or credit for inconvenience!"

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08:01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On July 23, 1998, at its duly noticed meeting, the Commission deferred the complaint as U S WEST indicated that the matter would be resolved by August 15, 1998. At its regularly scheduled meeting of September 10, 1998, the Commission again considered the matter. U S WEST stated that it had completed the project.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-13-1, 49-13-4, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, and ARSD 20:10:01:07:01 and 20:10:01:08:01. As U S WEST stated that it had completed the project, the Commission unanimously voted to dismiss the complaint and to close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that this complaint be dismissed and the docket closed.
