Dear Ms. Bonrud:

360networks (USA) inc. ("360"), by its regulatory consultants, hereby affirmatively notifies the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") of 360's intent to initially provide switched access services on a wholesale basis exclusively in Qwest Communications Corporation ("Qwest") geographic service territory, upon Commission grant of the Company's pending *Application for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Facilities-Based Local Exchange Access Services* within the State of South Dakota ("Application") in the above-referenced proceeding.

Paragraph 8 to 360's Application states, "Applicant initially intends to provide local exchange access service in the service area currently served by Qwest Communications Corporation and subsequently throughout the State of South Dakota." Although 360's intention has not changed, in light of questions raised regarding 360's specific longer term interests in serving South Dakota, 360 clarifies that for purposes of its pending Application, the Company will limit its entry into South Dakota to serving in Qwest service territory exclusively. This affirmative notice is consistent with the Company's July 20, 2006 response to Staff's July 7, 2006 Data Request 1-3.

On this basis, 360 agrees to be bound by Commission limitation to serve in Qwest service territory, so long as the Company is not precluded from applying to the Commission for expansion of the geographic scope of 360's operating authority in the future, should the Company decide to offer switched access services in non-Qwest telephone exchanges in South Dakota.


