

Re: Notification by TransAmerica Telecom, Inc. of Withdrawal Certification

Dear Sir or Madam:

On or about April 24, 2007, TransAmerica Telecom, Inc. ("TTI") was granted authority by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") to provide Interexchange Telecommunications Service ("Services") within the State of South Dakota.

Prior to commencement of operations in South Dakota, TTI determined that it would not be economical to provide Services within the State of South Dakota and through this letter, TTI is seeking permission of the Commission to withdraw its interexchange authority without prejudice.

Since TTI has neither provisioned nor invoiced any customers within South Dakota, no customer notification of the withdrawal is required. Therefore, since none of the consumers of South Dakota will be prejudiced or in any way harmed by this request, TTI respectfully requests that the Commission cancel TTI's certification, withdraw its tariff and delete TTI's name from the list of regulated utilities.
