## IMPORTANT NOTICE

Under a law the Telephone Assistance Plan (TAP) eligibility requirement, which, also, updates the Federal Lifeline Credit program requirement, changes the offer of telephone assistance to the subscriber at their primary residence. From here forward, annually you must provide proof of eligibility to receive the monthly credit to your phone bill. You are now eligible for TAP if you provide proof of participation in:

If you no longer receive benefits from any of the programs listed above or have not provided Farmers Mutual with proof of eligibility you will no longer receive TAP/Federal Lifeline Credit discount after February 1, 2007. Your February 10, 2007 billing will no longer reflect the discount.
