INTERVENORS MOTION TO COMPEL

Golden West Telecommunications Cooperative (Golden West), Great Plains Communications (Great Plains), Fort Randall Telephone Company (Fort Randall) and South Dakota Telecommunications Association (SDTA) (collectively referred to as Intervenor) hereby file the following Motion to Compel pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:22.01 and SDCL 15-6-37(a).

BACKGROUND

On September 9, 2008, Native American Telecom, LLC (Native Telecom) filed an Application for authority to provide local exchange service on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation pursuant to A.R.S.D. 20:10:32:03 and 20:10:32:15. In its Petition, Native Telecom requests authority to provide local exchange service on the Pine Ridge Indian reservation, which would include Golden West's, Great Plains' and Fort Randall's service areas. Golden West, Great Plains and Fort Randall are rural telecommunications companies that hold a certificate of authority to provide local exchange service in the geographic area where Native Telecom seeks to provide local exchange service. Golden West, Great Plains and Fort Randall were granted Intervention in this matter on October 21, 2008, as was SDTA.

MOTION TO COMPEL

On November 14, 2008, Intervenors served Interrogatories and Requests for Production electronically on Native Telecom by and through its attorney of record Gene DeJordy. To date, Native Telecom has not responded to the Interrogatories and Requests for Production.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:22.01, the taking and use of discovery before the Commission shall be in the same manner as is in the circuit courts of the state. SDCL 15-6-33(a) provides that the party upon whom interrogatories have been served shall serve a copy of the answers and objections, if any, within thirty days after the service of the interrogatories. SDCL 15-6-34(b) provides that a party upon whom a request for production has been served shall serve a written response within thirty days after the service of the request. Native Telecom has not responded and more than thirty days have passed.

The South Dakota Supreme Court has made it clear that the statutory mandate establishing the time period for discovery responses are not invitations, requests or even demands; they are mandatory. Schwartz v. Palachuk, 1999 SD 100, ¶ 23, 597 NW2d 442, 447 In fact, failure to respond to discovery responses can subject the answering party to sanctions including reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred in bringing a motion to compel. SDCL 15-6-37(a) 4

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Intervenors urge the Commission to enter an Order compelling Native Telecom to answer the Interrogatories and Requests for Production

served upon them and award the Intervenors their reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred in obtaining the Order to Compel.


