Qwest has reached settlement with the parties in this case and is filing these replacement pages to increase the floor for unidentified percent interstate usage (PIU) to 7% and change the effective date to July 14, 2009. Language to clarify the phrase "sufficient call detail" and to provide further detail concerning a dispute resolution process has also been added. Qwest has discussed these tariff changes with Verizon Business, AT&T, and the South Dakota Telecommunications Association and understands that they have no objections. Qwest has transmitted a copy of the settlement agreement to LECA and has asked their counsel for comment, but has not yet received an answer outlining their position. Qwest will continue to communicate with LECA and will apprise staff counsel when we receive their position.
