Analog-only TVs should continue to work as before with cable and satellite TV services, gaming consoles, VCRs, DVD players, and similar products.

On February 17, 2009, over-the-air TV stations will cease broadcasting in analog and switch to all-digital signals. After February 17, 2009, analog TV sets that use an antenna or rabbit ears for over-the-air TV (not connected to cable, satellite, or other pay-TV service) will be unable to display full-power broadcast programming unless the viewer takes action. Analog-only TVs connected to Knology's cable television service will continue to receive their current TV channels after February 17, 2009 and will not need a converter box. Analog-only TVs also should continue to work after February 17, 2009 to receive other types of over-the-air TV stations (low-power, Class A or translator stations). Gaming consoles, VCRs, DVD players and similar products will also continue to operate with existing analog TV sets. After February 17, 2009, analog TV sets not connected to a multi-channel service provider (such as Knology's cable television service) may need additional equipment (such as a converter box) to receive full-power broadcast programming or may have to be replaced. The federal government is offering discount coupons for viewers who need to purchase converter boxes for analog TV sets using an antenna or rabbit ears. 
