RE: Docket No. TC 12-036 AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc Access Tariff

Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

On May 1, 2012, in the above-noted docket, AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (“AT&T”) filed a change to its AT&T Access Services and Network Interconnection Services Tariff to implement the Federal Communications Commission’s (“FCC”), November 18, 2011, Intercarrier Compensation Reform Order. AT&T submits the following information in support of that filing:

- A populated FCC template spreadsheet¹ which was contained in the April 19, 2012, FCC Order, *In the Matter to be Filed in Support of 2012 Annual Access Filings*, WCB/Pricing File No 12-08, DA 12.565, that contains:
 - fiscal year 2011 intrastate demand (volume) for intrastate services (by rate element),
 - all intrastate rates in effect as of December 29, 2011,
 - all interstate rates in effect as of December 29, 2011,
- The calculations² of how the fiscal year 2011 intrastate demand for intrastate services was mapped into its interstate rate structure, and
- The methodology³ used to reduce intrastate rates to reflect the calculated revenue reductions.

The tariff page that was filed reflects that AT&T intends on maintaining its current rate structure at this time.

AT&T considers the information contained in the Attachments to be proprietary and confidential, as they contain details about AT&T’s revenues and volumes in South Dakota, which if provided publicly would cause competitive harm. AT&T requests that the report be treated as confidential for as long as the information is held by the Commission.
