2. We are trying to be very precise with our wording. We are moving toward the more industry-accepted term of "Switched Transport". It appears we did not catch all of the instances of the term "Switched Access Tandem" in the tariff. We will correct this and send proposed replacement pages.
3. This is an erroneous duplication. We will correct it and send proposed replacement pages.
4. These pages address the application of interstate rates to terminating toll VoIP-PSTN. Interstate rates do not apply to originating toll VoIP-PSTN traffic (intrastate rates apply to this traffic) until 2014.

2. On proposed Page 40, why was the definition of Switched Access Tandem deleted when this term is still used elsewhere in the tariff (for example page 45)?
3. On proposed Page 46, Section II, C.,2., a, please explain the functional difference between the first and second paragraphs.
4. Regarding the proposed changes to Pages 62, 63, and 64, considering these changes now focus these tariff sections on terminating intrastate access, where in the tariff is originating access discussed?
