Section 63.71 Application of Aventure Communication Technology, LLC to Discontinue Services

Aventure Communication Technology, LLC ("Aventure" or "Applicant") hereby seeks authorization pursuant to Section 214 (a) of the Communication Act of 1934, as amended, and 47 C.F.R. §63.71, to discontinue its provision of local, long distance (intrastate, interstate and international) and switched access telecommunications services to all of its customers. The Applicant intends to discontinue its wireline telephone operations entirely in the states of Iowa, Nebraska and South Dakota.

Applicant has operated as a non-dominant provider of local, long distance (intrastate, interstate and international) and switched access telecommunications services since 2006. As detailed below, the Applicant currently serves a limited number of customers in Iowa and has no customers in Nebraska or South Dakota.

Aventure individually notified affected retail and wholesale customers of its proposed discontinuance of service via a direct mailing.

The applicant provides the following information pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance, Reduction or Impairment:

Aventure proposes to discontinue service to all customers on August 10, 2013, or upon the Commission's approval of the discontinuance, whichever occurs later.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected:

The local, long distance (intrastate, interstate and international) and switched access telecommunications services that the Applicant proposes to discontinue are offered to customers in Iowa, Nebraska and South Dakota, although Aventure has only served customers in Iowa.

4. Brief Description of Types of Service Affected:

Aventure will discontinue its wireline local, long distance (intrastate, interstate and international) and switched access telecommunications services to all of its existing customers. This discontinuance will affect 14 business and 169 residential retail customers in Iowa. It will also affect 14 wholesale switched access customers. Aventure has no customers in South Dakota or Nebraska. The Company has notified its Iowa customers that they should contact alternative service providers as soon as possible to avoid any interruptions in their service. The affected retail

customers reside in service territory served by the incumbent carrier, Northwest Iowa Telephone (d/b/a Long Lines), which offers services comparable to those offered by Aventure.

5. Brief Description of Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers:

The Applicant has provided written customer notice of the planned discontinuance in accordance with the requirements of section 63.71 (a) of the Commission's Rules by notices dated May 9, 2013 (to retail customers) and May 10, 2013 (to wholesale access customers). Notice to retail customers were sent via U.S. Mail on May 9, 2013; notices to wholesale customers were mailed between May 10 and May 14, 2013. The customer notices are appended hereto as Exhibit A.

A copy of this application will be submitted to the public utility commissions and to the governors of the states in which Aventure proposes to discontinue service and to the Secretary of Defense, Special Assistant for Telecommunications, as required under Section 63.71, concurrent with this filing. A service list is provided in Exhibit B.

Conclusion

Pursuant to Section 214 (a) of the Communication Act of 1934, as amended, and 47 C.F.R. §63.71, Aventure Communication Technology, LLC understands that this application will be automatically granted on the 31st day after the Public Notice is released, with no Commission notification to the Applicant, unless the Commission has notified the Applicant that the grant will not be automatically effective.

Aventure Communication Technology, L.L.C. will be discontinuing the provision of its wireline local and long distance (intrastate, interstate and international) telephone services to end users located in Iowa, effective August 10, 2013. Aventure will be simultaneously discontinuing the provision of switched access services for origination of traffic from or termination of traffic to those customers.
