

2-1. Regarding your response to Data Request No. 1, question 3, please specifically describe how telecommunications relay services will be provided.

ANPI Business, LLC's telecommunications relay service (TRS) is commonly referred to as Internet Protocol (IP) Relay Service. It is a text-based form of TRS that uses the Internet to connect the call between the person with a hearing or speech disability and a Communications Assistant (CA). The call is generally handled just like a TTY-based TRS call. The user can use a computer or another web-enabled device to communicate with the CA. The second leg of the call, as with traditional TRS, is from the CA to the receiving party via voice telephone through the public switched telephone network.
