1-3 Farmers Mutual Telephone Company has not yet developed a "broadband plan" for purposes of FCC compliance, because such plan is not yet required by the FCC, for the current/relevant reporting period.

However, Farmers Mutual Telephone Company offers broadband service to all customer locations within its exchange at speeds exceeding the FCC's prescribed 4 mbps/1 mbps (download and upload) standards. The typical broadband service offered to residential customers is 20 mbps download and upload. The typical broadband service offered to single-line business customer is 5 mbps download and upload. The services are provided over fiber to the premise (FTTP).
