


CERTIFICATION OF JAMES VALLEY WIRELESS, LLC

Pursuant to § 54.313(a)(6) for High-cost Recipients, James Valley Wireless, LLC hereby certifies that it is able to function in emergency situations as set forth in § 54.202(a)(2). James Valley Wireless, LLC is able to remain functional in an emergency situation through the use of back-up power to ensure functionality without an external power source. James Valley Wireless, LLC has backup battery (or equivalent power) reserve in its central office, which enables it to provide service for a reasonable period of time if external power is lost. James Valley Wireless, LLC's network is engineered to handle reasonable excess traffic in the event of traffic spikes resulting from emergency situations. James Valley Wireless, LLC has redundancy in its network for use in re-rerouting traffic when facilities are damaged.
