Re: AT&T Corp.'s Access Services and Network Interconnection Services

Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

On July 1, 2014, all current PVUC (Percent VOIP Usage Factor) values that represented customer VOIP traffic will be changed to zero. Pursuant to the FCC's Report and Order, FCC 11-161 and related subsequent Orders governing intercarrier compensation, AT&T's Corp. announces the following changes to its processes and tariffs as of July 1, 2014. Customers must provide an originating PVUC by June 1, 2014. This PVUC represents the percentage (whole number) of the originating intrastate access MOU that the customer receives from the Telephone Company end users in the state (MOU which are sent from the Telephone Company) that are terminated in IP format to the customer's end user.


