RE: Airus, Inc.: S.D. PUC Tariff No. 1 - Reduce Terminating Access Rates Pursuant to FCC ICC/USF Order

Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

Airus, Inc. (Airus) hereby submits revised pages for Airus SD PUC Tariff No. 1. These revisions are being filed in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC's") *Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, *et al.* (FCC 11-161, rel. 11/18/11) and subsequent related orders, and Sections 51.911 and 61.26 of the FCC's rules. This submission includes:

- 1st Revised Sheet 1, Replaces Original Sheet 1
- 1st Revised Sheet 2, Replaces Original Sheet 2
- 1st Revised Sheet 105, Replaces Original Sheet 105

Airus hereby adds a cross-reference and URL hyperlink at page 105 that references its interstate access tariff for the intrastate end office terminating and tandem terminating access rate elements. This will result in the intrastate end office terminating and tandem terminating access rate elements mirroring the Company's interstate end office terminating and tandem terminating access rate elements that will go into effect in July 2015 to implement Phase IV of the FCC's intercarrier compensation reform regime. These tariff revisions also modify the rate structure to establish separate originating and terminating rate elements for intrastate end office and tandem switched access. The rate elements for originating intrastate end office and tandem switched access do not change. This filing is requested to become effective on July 31, 2015 (the same day Airus' interstate access tariff revisions are expected to go into effect).
