

Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

In response to the Commission Staff's request dated November 9, 2016, Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC ("CenturyLink") and Onvoy Spectrum, LLC ("Onvoy") state that the above-referenced Agreement allows for the exchange of traffic between Onvoy's wireless network and CenturyLink's network. The agreement covers the types of traffic that can be exchanged and what types of traffic cannot be exchanged, and it outlines wireless interconnection requirements, trunking requirements, and ancillary services that are available such as LNP, network security and rates for services provided. The agreement also contains standard general terms covering definitions, length of agreement, disputes, billing, assignment, governing law, insurance and limitation of liabilities.

Approval of the Agreement will serve the public interest and offer benefits to consumers in South Dakota. The ability to exchange traffic between Onvoy and CenturyLink benefits customers of both companies and all wireless users in South Dakota. For these reasons, Onvoy and CenturyLink respectfully submit that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be furthered by approval of this wireless interconnection agreement.
