

Billing Name and Address Notification

If you have an unlisted or non-published telephone number, you have a choice. If you do not want your BNA released by our company for third party billed calls, collect calls and calling card calls, we need affirmative notification from you within 30 days of this notice. If you provide us with such notification, your ability to make calling card calls or to receive collect calls or third number billed calls could be denied. 
