Dear Ms. Semmler:

On September 17, 2018, Valley Telecommunications Cooperative Association, Inc. ("Valley") received a letter from NextGen Communications, Inc ("NextGen") purporting to serve as a "formal Bona Fide Request" by NextGen to initiate negotiations for an interconnection agreement with Valley "pursuant to Section 251 of the Communications Act (47 U.S.C § 251) and the South Dakota Administrative Code Section 20:10:32:37 (SDLRC (sic) 20:10:32:37)." The request fails to designate under which subdivision of Section 251 the request is made.

At this time, it is not Valley's position that the request is not a bona fide request. Valley does, however, seek clarification from NextGen and the Commission that its request for interconnection is a request made pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 251(c) and SDCL § 49-31-79 and, as such, is subject to the rural "exemption" review process set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 251(f)(1) and/or the "suspension or modification" procedures available to rural carriers under 47 U.S.C. § 251(f)(2).
