Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

Momentum Telecom, Inc. (“Momentum”), through undersigned counsel, hereby requests that the Commission withdraw its Certificate of Authority in the State of South Dakota.¹ Momentum currently has no customers in South Dakota, and is not providing any telecommunications services in South Dakota. Thus, there will be no adverse impact on any consumer, and a formal notice to consumers of the discontinuance is unnecessary.

In light of the fact that Momentum no longer intends to retain authority to provide telecommunications services in the State of South Dakota, Momentum requests that the Commission cancel its Certificate of Authority effective immediately.²
