APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY ON BEHALF OF VALLEY COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

COMES NOW, Valley Communications, Inc., ("Valley Communications") a South Dakota Corporation, by and through the undersigned counsel, and requests pursuant to A.R.S.D. §§ 20:10:32:03 and 20:10:24:02 of the Public Utilities Commission's ("Commission") Administrative Rules, a certificate of authority and submits the following information in support thereof:

(2) A description of the legal and organizational structure of the applicant's company (A.R.S.D. §§ 20:10:24:02(2) and 20:10:32:03 (2)):

Valley Communications, a South Dakota Corporation, was organized on January 18, 1994 and is a wholly owned subsidiary of Valley Telecommunications Cooperative Association, Inc., a South Dakota Cooperative.

(6) A description of the applicant's experience providing any telecommunication services in South Dakota or in other jurisdictions, including the types of services provided, and the dates and nature of state or federal authorization to provide the services. (A.R.S.D §§ 20:10:32:03 (6)):

Valley FiberCom is currently not providing telecommunications service in South Dakota or in other jurisdictions. However, the company will share managerial and technical resources with its parent cooperative who has been providing telecommunications service since 1952.

(7) Names and addresses of applicant's affiliates, subsidiaries, and parent organizations, if any. (A.R.S.D. §§ 20:10:32:03 (7)):

Valley Communications' parent company is as follows:

 - (a) Information indicating the classes of customers the applicant intends to serve.

Residential and business customers.

(b) Information indicating the extent to and time-frame by which applicant will provide service through the use of its own facilities, the purchase of unbundled network elements, or resale.

Valley FiberCom proposes to provide local service through the use of its own facilities. Construction is estimated to be completed between May of 2019 and the end of 2020, which is the time-frame by which applicant will provide services.

(c) A description of all facilities that the applicant will utilize to furnish the proposed local exchange services, including any facilities of underlying carriers.

All services will be provided over Valley FiberCom's fiber-based facilities.

(d) Information identifying the types of services it seeks authority to provide by reference to the general nature of the service.

Valley FiberCom will provide local telephone exchange service, and interexchange long distance service and broadband to residential and business customers.

(9) A service area map or narrative description indicating with particularity the geographic are proposed to be served by the applicant. (A.R.S.D. §§ 20:10:24:02(8) and 20:10:32:03 (9)):

Valley FiberCom intends to offer its services initially in the territory now served by CenturyLink in the Cities of Volga, Arlington, Lake Preston and DeSmet. The Company will adhere to the service area maps defined by CenturyLink.

- (10) Information regarding the technical competence of the applicant to provide its proposed local exchange services including: (A.R.S.D. §§ 20:10:32:03:(10)):
 - (a) A description of the education and experience of the applicant's management personnel who will oversee the proposed local exchange services.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit B** is a description of the education and experience of Valley FiberCom's management personnel.

(b) Information regarding policies, personnel, or arrangements made by the applicant which demonstrates the applicant's ability to respond to customer complaints and inquiries promptly and to perform facility and equipment maintenance necessary to ensure compliance with any commission quality of service requirements.

Valley FiberCom will be directly responsible for all customer inquiries and complaints. The telephone number for customer inquiries and complaints will be provided by Valley FiberCom on the customer bill. Customer service will be available seven days a week, twenty-four hours a day.

(11) Information explaining how the applicant will provide customers with access to emergency services such as 911 or enhanced 911, operator services, interexchange services, directory assistance, and telecommunications relay services. (A.R.S.D. §§ 20:10:32:03 (11)):

Valley FiberCom will connect with both the Brookings County PSAP (PSAP ID 6117) and the Beadle County PSAP (PSAP ID 6146) via the 911 selective router and will provide enhanced 911 consistent with current E911 requirements. Valley FiberCom will contact the proper county officials and will provision and test E911 before offering any services. Valley FiberCom will use Valley Telecommunications Cooperative's provider for operator and directory assistance services. Valley FiberCom will configure its switch to provide and properly route all telecommunications relay services. Valley FiberCom will connect with the SDN Communications' tandem switch and utilize Express Communications to provide interexchange services. Both inter- and intrastate equal access will be provided.

(12) For the most recent 12 month period, financial statements of the applicant consisting of balance sheets, income statements, and cash flow statements. The applicant shall provide audited financial statements, if available. (A.R.S.D §§ 20:10:24:02 (9) and 20:10:32:03 (12)):

Valley FiberCom will enter into interconnection agreements with CenturyLink and other certificated LECs as customer demand warrants.

Valley FiberCom anticipates negotiating the interconnection agreements concurrent with the processing of this application.

Valley FiberCom intends to market through door to door campaigns, open house events, brochures and flyers, as well as newspaper and radio ads.
