## Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

Network Billing Systems, LLC and Birch Communications, LLC¹ (together, the "Fusion SD Companies") respectfully submit this letter to notify the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") that on June 3, 2019, their parent company, Fusion Connect, Inc. and all of its U.S. subsidiaries, including the Fusion SD Companies (collectively, "Fusion"), filed for protection under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York (the "Petition").²

Fusion filed for Chapter 11 protection in order to restructure its capital structure. Following completion of the proposed restructuring, Fusion expects to emerge financially stronger. Importantly, the filing of the Petition does not reflect, or result in, any immediate changes to Fusion's current operations. The Fusion SD Companies continue to serve their customers on an uninterrupted basis and the Chapter 11 filing does not in any way alter the rates, terms and conditions under which they provide those services to their customers. Thus, the bankruptcy filing itself will be transparent to the customers of the Fusion SD

The Fusion SD Companies are authorized to provide telecommunications services in South Dakota. Network Billing Systems, LLC: Docket No. TC98-195 (January 6, 1999); Birch Communications, LLC: Docket No. TC17-067 (Feb. 14, 2018).

In re Fusion Connect, Inc., et al., Debtors, Case No. 19-11811 (Bankr. S.D.N.Y. Jun. 3, 2019). As a consequence of this filing, the legal status of Fusion is now changed to debtors-in-possession.
