1.3. Explain how Clarity spent the South Dakota Broadband grant money in 2020 and how Clarity plans to spend the money awarded for 2021.

Response: 2020 South Dakota Broadband Grant: The grant money was used to fund projects in Flyger, Volin, Monroe, and Copper Oaks. All locations were upgraded to 1GbE down/500 Mb up technologies. *See* Confidential Attachment 1.3 for additional details.

2021 South Dakota Broadband Grant: The grant money will be used to serve 214 unserved and underserved households and businesses. Clarity will provide high speed data in the form of FTTH in the counties of Turner and Yankton. The network would cover the townships of Walshtown, Marindahl, Mayfield, Salem, Spring Valley, and Childstown. In addition, the upgrades would include portions of rural Turner and Yankton Counties.

1.4 Clarity's filed 5-year plan in Exhibit B indicates a Project List for 2021-2026, yet no expenditures are listed for 2026. Provide an update to the plan indicating the planned expenditures for 2026.

1.4. Does Clarity have a current plan to extend additional facilities in the rural area of the Chancellor and Lennox exchanges? If so, provide estimated schedule and facilities planned for deployment.

Response: Since we have Hurley and Parker scheduled to buildout over the 5-year plan, the Lennox/Chancellor exchanges would start after 2026. We would estimate FTTH deployment in 2027 and 2028.
