This letter and the enclosed filing supersede filings submitted on August 15, 2023, and August 17, 2023. The filing, attached at this time, reflects changes recommended by Staff.

Effective July 1, 2023, MetTel ceased billing for Switched Access services. Rate reductions, mandated by the FCC over the last number of years, have reduced switched access rates to a level where it is no longer economical to continue billing for these services. Calls originating from and terminating to MetTel end users will continue to be completed normally by the underlying ILEC from whom MetTel purchases end user lines. Following discussion with PUC Staff, this filing revises all switched access rates to zero. MetTel will maintain its Access Services Tariff No. 3 on file with the Commission.
