SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

CenturyLink Communications, LLC (CenturyLink) and Level 3 Telecom¹ (Level 3)
hereby apply for authority pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications
Commission's (Commission) rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, and Section 214 of the Communications
Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, to grandfather certain voice and data services
(Affected Services) provided by CenturyLink or Level 3 in all 50 states, Washington, D.C.,
Puerto Rico, and any international locations where offered.

2. Date of planned service discontinuance, reduction or impairment

As of October 1, 2026, or as soon thereafter as the necessary regulatory approvals can be obtained, the Affected Services will no longer be available for new orders to new or existing customers and will no longer be available for renewal for existing customers. Customers currently subscribing to the Affected Services under existing contracts will continue to be supported until the expiration of the applicable service term pursuant to contract. Lumen will only accept move, add, or change orders (MACDs) in limited scenarios (e.g., disconnects, MACDs required by contract). If Affected Services are subject to contractual auto-renewal provisions, customers have been notified that, subject to the terms of their contracts, the Affected Services will terminate at the conclusion of the current service term.

3. Points of geographic areas of service affected

Lumen seeks authority to grandfather the Affected Services in all 50 states, Washington D.C., Puerto Rico, and any international locations where offered.

5. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers

Lumen notified its customers of the planned grandfathering of the Affected Services in a letter sent via U.S. Mail on August 6, 2026. These customers were notified that the proposed grandfathering would take effect on October 1, 2026, or as soon after that date as authorized by the relevant regulatory authorities. Copies of the four forms of customer notification letters Lumen used are attached hereto.³

6. Whether the carrier is considered dominant or non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued, reduced or impaired

CenturyLink and Level 3 are non-dominant carriers with regard to the services to be grandfathered.

7. Service

In accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a), Lumen has mailed a copy of this Application to the Governor and public utility commission of each affected state identified in Paragraph 3, above;⁴ to any federally-recognized Tribal Nations with authority over the Tribal lands in the geographic areas identified in Paragraph 3, above; and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications under the Secretary of Defense.⁵

CONCLUSION

The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by grandfathering of the Affected Services, as customers have been given significant notice of the planned action. In addition, to the extent the Affected Services are primarily resold services (albeit often including Lumen add-on services), those which are strictly resale offerings may continue to be available from the underlying provider of those services. Accordingly, Lumen requests streamlined processing and automatic grant of this Application in accordance with Section 63.71(f)(1) of the Commission's rules.
