And the question today is shall the Commission grant Superior's motion to shorten time for responses to discovery requests and to extend discovery cutoff date.

MR. KOENECKE: Mr. Chairman.

MR. KOENECKE: If I might, I would like to announce we have settled the matter between ourselves in the telephone discussions that continued through earlier this afternoon. We are going to ask the Commission to set the discovery deadline as February 25th. That is one week after the Staff testimony is due in this matter. And that would give us all a chance to look at Staff's filed testimony, filings and discovery requests which were necessary in the time period before the hearing which is to start I believe on March 20th, if I recall correctly.

And with respect to the motion to shorten the time for responses to the recently propounded discovery from Superior, we have agreed that we'll file our answers on Monday, the 13th of December. That shortens the time period by two or three days, depending on how you read the code when you were served with notice. They were

propounded on the 15th, and we've agreed that we can answer those -- those discovery requests by then. And I believe that fully states the agreement between the parties. Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON SAHR: Thank you. Mr. Meierhenry, do you have anything to add? Mr. Meierhenry, are you on the line? I will take that as a no. We can't track who is on the line at this point in time. And I will ask for a little help from the people on the conference call. Can you hear us in Sioux Falls?

UNIDENTIFIED VOICE: We can hear you, Bob.

CHAIRPERSON SAHR: Thank you very much. I think we had a drop. I noticed there was a beep during the last proceeding, and maybe that is what happened. I will look to Staff. Have you had the ability or someone else had the ability to take a look at this and maybe discuss with the parties?

MS. CREMER: I did talk to Mr. Moody 1:30 or so, and he did say that they had settled in exactly the manner that Mr. Koenecke has stated.

CHAIRPERSON SAHR: I'm comfortable that we could go ahead and take action on this. Certainly if something needs to be taken care of after the fact, we can look at it at that point in time, but I don't know there is any reason to hold this over. So I guess I will see if there
