CHAIRMAN HANSON: Good morning, everyone. I'm Gary Hanson, and I'm a PUC Commissioner. I'm with Commissioners Bob Sahr and Dusty Johnson. This is room -- we are in Room 412 of the State Capitol Building, Pierre, South Dakota. This is the time and place, Monday, August 22, 2005, 9 a.m., for the Public Utilities Commission meeting.

We'll first check the persons who are joining us telephonically. Tal Wieczorek.

MR. WIECZOREK: I'm here.
CHAIRMAN HANSON: Is there anyone else with you there that may be participating?

MR. WIECZOREK: Just me.
CHAIRMAN HANSON: And Vantage Point. Larry Thompson is present here, and I believe you said there are some people on the phone with us, some folks from Vantage Point joining us.

MS. HARPER: Correct. Wendy Harper.
CHAIRMAN HANSON: Good morning.
MS. HARPER: Good morning.
CHAIRMAN HANSON: Excuse me. Good
afternoon. I have a Motion to read, and then -- In the Matter of CT05-001, and then the Commissioners are going to open up the proceedings for comments

from the participants.
We are not looking for additional argument. We are specifically looking for comments on the Motion. It's a lengthy Motion, and we want to make certain that the functionality of the Motion will work.

In the Matter of CT05-001, I move that we rule on all of the pending motions generally in accordance with staff counsel's recommendations. Specifically, I move that Golden West's Motion to Prohibit WWC from Contesting the Accuracy of Data Provided, Motion to Strike Late-filed Claim, and Motion to Compel, and Western Wireless's Motion to Bifurcate be denied.

Instead, the parties shall each file amendments to their proceedings to conform to the evidence revealed through discovery and to reflect any additional claims and answers thereto related to Golden West's intercarrier billings to WWC that have come to light during the discovery and analysis process.

By August 31 the parties shall submit to the Commission their proposals for a procedural schedule for the remainder of this case. The next available dates for hearing in this matter are

November 7, 8, 9 with a 3 p.m. ending time on the 8th.

I further move that Golden West's Motion to Permit Additional Discovery be granted to allow full exploration by both parties of the minutes of use data and other issues and also to address any additional claims and defenses that are added or modified through amendments to the Pleadings.

Further Motion that staff counsel's suggestions be adopted in the form of an order that in connection with the extension of discovery the parties' technical experts shall meet in a good-faith effort to resolve the billing data issues, including access on reasonable terms to the data in the possession of the other party.

This meeting of the parties' respective data experts shall take place at a location acceptable to them and to staff, or if they cannot agree, in the Commission's conference room. Staff and staff counsel are directed to be present at such meeting to assist the parties in attempting to resolve any disputes their experts may have involving the data, access to data, and related issues.

The parties shall submit their proposed date for this meeting in their procedural schedule
proposals.
Lastly, I move that Golden West's Motion to Postpone Hearing be granted to allow for the filing of additional or amended claims and to conduct additional discovery so that all issues involving the billing in question can be addressed and resolved in this proceeding.

I move that the hearing in this matter be continued until November 7, 2005 commencing at 10 a.m., continuing at 8:30 a.m. November 8, 2005, and carrying over to November 9, if necessary, unless the parties' procedural schedule submittals demonstrate that this date is not available for them, at which case alternative hearing dates will be scheduled.

That's the end of the Motion, and I'm interested in hearing comments from -- excuse me. The Commissioners are interested in hearing comments from the parties.

Who would like to go first? Good afternoon. MS. POLLMAN ROGERS: Good afternoon. CHAIRMAN HANSON: First I wish to make certain that Tal is still on the line with us. MR. WIECZOREK: I am. CHAIRMAN HANSON: All right. Thank
you.
MS. POLLMAN ROGERS: Commissioners, thank you for the opportunity to comment. I believe that on behalf of my clients that we think that this Motion is very fair. We are certainly willing to meet with the experts from Western Wireless in trying to resolve some of these issues on our own and with staff's involvement. I appreciated Mr. Wiest's suggestions on that when she made her recommendation last week.

I guess I would just have one question or query. I believe that we had a couple of other pending motions that were heard on Friday, and I do not recall that there was a ruling on those. Specifically, the Motion to Strike the Double Damages Claim. But maybe you ruled on that and I forgot about that.

MR. SMITH: Those were both ruled -the double damages and attorneys fees were both granted, the Motions to Dismiss.

MS. POLLMAN ROGERS: Thank you.
That clarifies that. No. We're happy to cooperate with this Motion and feel it's fair.

Thank you.
MR. WIECZOREK: This is

Talbot Wieczorek from -- I'm sorry. This is Talbot Wieczorek on behalf of Western Wireless. The one day to -- we're supposed to file amended Pleadings did I get it August 20 -- excuse me. August 31; is that correct?

MR. SMITH: May I address that, Mr. Chairman? No. That's just for a date to file a proposed procedural schedule.

MR. WIECZOREK: Okay. That's proposed procedural.

MR. SMITH: It may be that you guys would decide an appropriate date for filing amendments that are known now, and there may be other stuff that comes up. It might be a month from now or whatever you think.

Just by the 30th come in with your ideas, and I'm assuming and hoping that would occur after some suggestion between the parties and staff, and if you want me to be on the call, I would be willing to do so. Let's just try to come up with something that will work.

Is that okay, Tal?
MR. WIECZOREK: Yes. I'm always hip
for coming up with something that works.

> MR. SMITH: Good. Did you catch
that word there, Cheri.
MR. WIECZOREK: That's going to date me back to the '60s, being hip.

MR. SMITH: Okay.
CHAIRMAN HANSON: Tal, did you have any other questions or comments?

MR. WIECZOREK: I do appreciate the Commission laying some of this out, and I appreciate that we have a date certain for the hearing to work against to kind of keep everybody's feet to the fire. Because the other thing that's kind of looming out there, just for the Commission's understanding, is these Interconnection Agreements are done this year unless we negotiate to continue them further.

So it would be nice to actually resolve some of these interconnection issues before we start fighting over the new Interconnection Agreement.

VICE CHAIRMAN SAHR: You mean negotiating, right, Tal?

MR. WIECZOREK: Strongly
negotiating.
CHAIRMAN HANSON: Thank you. Are
there any further comments on the Motion?
MS. AILTS WIEST: No. Staff has no problems or nothing to add. Thank you.

CHAIRMAN HANSON: If there are no further comments on the Motion, then the Motion stands as I stated it, and subject to a second and concurrence.

VICE CHAIRMAN SAHR: Mr. Chairman, I would gladly second that. And my experience is I realize that there's some impetus to get to a hearing. At the same time, my experience over the last few years has been that the more preparation the parties can put into it, especially when you're dealing with important information and data, that goes a long ways towards having a better ultimate resolution.

And hopefully there's still the door open to try to figure out ways that this might be settled and avoid the hearing in the first place.

COMMISSIONER JOHNSON: Mr. Chairman, I concur.
