On July 8, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Thelma "Sally" Fox, Huron, South Dakota (Complainant), against Touchtone Communications (Touchtone) regarding the unauthorized billing for services. Touchtone does not have a certificate of authority to act as a telecommunications company. Complainant alleged that her long distance phone service was switched to Touchtone prior to her May 1999, billing without authorization and that she has been unable to resolve the dispute. She is seeking reimbursement of the charges and penalties assessed.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On November 1, 1999, at a duly noticed meeting, Commission Staff informed the Commission that the parties had reached a settlement as to the billing and penalties and the Complainant wished to have the complaint dismissed and the docket closed.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-13-1, 49-13-4, 49-13-13, 49-13-14.1, 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-11, 49-31-89 through 49-31-96, inclusive, and ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09. The Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that this complaint be dismissed and the docket be closed.
