On July 28, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint by Ross R. Milliken, Belle Fourche, South Dakota (Complainant), against U S WEST Communications, Inc. (U S WEST) regarding poor service. The Complainant reports poor service and multiple outages on the business line for the Funeral Home of the Northern Hills. As a result of poor service he has had to hire personnel to answer the business line from his home. The Complainant is seeking compensation in the amount of \$98.00 to reimburse additional employee expenses the funeral home has incurred due to lack of adequate telephone service.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On August 17, 1999, at a duly noticed meeting, Commission Staff informed the Commission that the parties had reached a settlement and the Complainant wished to have the complaint dismissed and the docket closed.


The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-13-1, 49-13-4, 49-13-13, 49-13-14.1, 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-11, 49-31-60, 49-31-61, and ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09. The Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that this complaint be dismissed and the docket be closed.




