On August 11, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by William and Eileen Reidy, Sioux Falls, South Dakota (Complainants), against Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) and U.S. WEST Communications, Inc. (U.S. WEST). The Complainants alleged unauthorized switching of long distance services and ask that the provisions of the law for a \$1,000 payment to the consumer be enforced and applied here.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On August 25, 1999, at a duly noticed meeting, the Commission considered this matter and determined that there was probable cause that an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission was committed by Sprint and U S WEST.

On September 20, 1999, U S WEST filed a Motion to Dismiss U S WEST as a respondent in the complaint. On October 1, 1999, Sprint filed an Amended Answer stating that its original assertion that U S WEST was at fault in the switching of the Complainants was in error. Sprint stated that the Complainants were improperly switched as a result of a keying error of a Sprint employee. Based on Sprint's Amended Answer, the Commission voted unanimously to grant U S WEST's Motion to Dismiss. A hearing in this matter was scheduled for December 2, 1999, in Sjoux Falls, South Dakota, and notice of the hearing was issued by the Commission on November 2, 1999. At a regularly scheduled meeting on November 15, 1999, Commission staff informed the Commission that the matter was resolved. The Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the complaint, close the docket and cancel the hearing. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint in this docket shall be dismissed, the docket shall be closed and the hearing scheduled in this matter shall be cancelled.
