ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT AND CLOSING DOCKET

CT99-040

On September 17, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Jane Ham of Custer, South Dakota (Complainant), against Qwest Communications, Inc. (Qwestl) alleging that Qwest switched telecommunications services from AT&T to Qwest on August 3, 1999, without authorization. Complainant requested a return to AT&T and appropriate damages.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint. On October 7, 1999, the Commission determined that there was probable cause that an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission was committed by U S WEST. The matter was scheduled for hearing on December 7, 1999.

On December 6, 1999, the Commission Staff received a telephone call from the Complainant indicating that she was satisfied with a resolution of the matter and that the case should be considered closed.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

On December 14, 1999, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
