## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA

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IN THE MATTER OF THE COMPLAINT FILED BY BRIAN AND RENEE D. COLEY, DBA CAMBRIDGE GALLERY/SIOUX GLASS AND DOOR, SIOUX FALLS, SOUTH DAKOTA, AGAINST PREFERRED BILLING REGARDING UNAUTHORIZED SWITCHING OF SERVICES ORDER FINDING PROBABLE CAUSE AND NOTICE REQUIRING ANSWER

On August 16, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Brian and Renee D. Coley, dba Cambridge Gallery/Sioux Glass and Door, Sioux Falls, South Dakota (Complainants), against Preferred Billing (Preferred), regarding alleged unauthorized charges on their long distance bill. Complainants request that the unauthorized charges be removed from their bill.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On August 25, 1999, at a duly noticed meeting, Commission Staff recommended a finding of probable cause due to unresolved factual issues.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-13-1, 49-13-4, 49-13-13, 49-13-14.1, 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-11, 49-31-89 through 49-31-96, inclusive, and ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09. The Commission voted unanimously to find probable cause. It is therefore

ORDERED, that pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, the Commission finds that there is probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice, or omission and that the complaint shall be forwarded to Preferred and Preferred shall file with the Commission its answer in writing within twenty (20) days of service of this order.
