ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT AND CLOSING DOCKET

CT99-090

On December 23, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by James Melgaard, Pierre, South Dakota (Complainant), against US West Communications, Inc. (US WEST) and Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint). The Complainant alleges that his long distance service was switched from AT&T to Sprint and that he only used VarTec dialaround service for interstate long distance calls. Complainant seeks rerating of the calls in question to 10 cents per minute, a credit for overcharges billed by Sprint and US WEST and a letter from US WEST stating that there will be no further billings by US WEST or Sprint for out of state calls.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint. This matter was scheduled for a probable cause determination at the Commission's regularly scheduled January 6, 2000, meeting.

On January 5, 2000, the Commission Staff received a phone call from Complainant indicating that there had been a resolution of the matter and that the case should be considered closed.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13 and 49-31.

On January 6, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
