On December 8, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Sandy Curran, Sisseton, South Dakota (Complainant), against OLS, Inc. (OLS) regarding switching telecommunications services through deceptive tactics.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint. Probable cause was found against OLS on December 28, 1999.

On June 14, 2000, the Commission Staff received word from the Complainant stating that the complaint against OLS had been resolved.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-38,

On June 20, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
