On August 2, 2000, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Todd Huntimer on behalf of Global Polymer Industries, Inc., Arlington, South Dakota (Complainant), against EqualNet Corporation (EqualNet) regarding unauthorized switching of services.

On August 8, 2000, the complaint was faxed to EqualNet. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, EqualNet was notified that it must satisfy the complaint or file an answer in writing with the Commission by August 28, 2000. The Commission has not received an answer from EqualNet to this complaint. Commission Staff received word from the Complainant stating that the complaint against EqualNet had been resolved.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-38, 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

On September 13, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
