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IN THE MATTER OF THE COMPLAINT FILED BY KENNETH ERICKSON, WATERTOWN, SOUTH DAKOTA, AGAINST WILTEL, INC. AND OLS, INC. REGARDING UNAUTHORIZED SWITCHING OF SERVICES ORDER FINDING PROBABLE CAUSE AND NOTICE REQUIRING ANSWER CT99-089

On December 23, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Kenneth Erickson, Watertown, South Dakota (Complainant), against WilTel, Inc. (WilTel) and OLS, Inc. (OLS) regarding alleged unauthorized switching of services. Complainant requests "that the rules and laws of the state of SD be upheld. This company should be held responsible for their illegal actions."

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On January 6, 2000, at a duly noticed meeting, Commission Staff recommended a finding of probable cause due to unresolved factual issues.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-38, 49-31, 49-3

ORDERED, that pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, the Commission finds that there is probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice, or omission and that the complaint shall be forwarded to WilTel and OLS and WilTel and OLS shall satisfy the complaint or file with the Commission their answers in writing within twenty (20) days of service of this order.
