On March 15, 2001, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Richard and Nancie Hagggar, Sioux Falls, South Dakota (Complainants), against WebNet Communications, Inc. (WebNet) regarding misrepresenting rates.

On March 16, 2001, the complaint was faxed to WebNet. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, WebNet was notified that it must satisfy the complaint or file an answer in writing with the Commission by April 5, 2001. The Commission has not received an answer from WebNet to this complaint.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

By order dated April 17, 2001, a hearing was scheduled for May 8, 2001, beginning at 8:30 A.M., in Room 412 of the State Capitol Building, 500 E. Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota. Commission Staff has now been informed that settlement had been reached in this matter, so therefore the hearing is cancelled. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the hearing scheduled for May 8, 2001, is cancelled.
