On December 18, 2001, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Don R. Larsen, Sisseton, South Dakota (Complainant), against AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T) regarding delayed services.

On December 19, 2001, the complaint was faxed to AT&T. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, AT&T was notified that it must satisfy the complaint or file an answer in writing with the Commission by January 8, 2002. On January 8, 2002, the Commission received an answer from AT&T. Commission Staff was informed that settlement had been reached in this matter.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-85 and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:24.

On February 26, 2002, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
