On February 12, 1997, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received Black Hills Power & Light Company's (BHP&L's) 1996 Economic Development Annual Report. On March 12, 1997, the Commission received BHP&L's proposed Economic Development Plan for 1997. The report and proposed plan were filed in accordance with the settlement agreement reached between BHP&L and Commission Staff, and approved by the Commission in the company's most recent rate case filing, Docket EL95-003. The Commission approved BHP&L's Economic Development Plan for 1996 on December 5, 1995.

For 1997, BHP&L's proposed economic development plan budget is \$279,000. The actual expenditures for the 1996 economic development plan were \$34,147.11.

At its regularly scheduled April 15, 1997, meeting, the Commission reviewed BHP&L's 1996 Economic Development Annual Report and Economic Development Plan for 1997. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A. After review of the report and plan, the Commission found that they are just and reasonable and voted to approve them. It is therefore

ORDERED, that BHP&L's 1996 Economic Development Annual Report and Economic Development Plan for 1997 are approved as filed.
