ORDER APPROVING
ACCOUNTING AND FUEL
CLAUSE TREATMENT OF
MISO ASM CHARGES AND
REVENUES AND
APPROVING REVISIONS TO
XCEL'S FUEL CLAUSE
RIDER TARIFF

On December 24, 2008, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Xcel Energy (Xcel) for approval of proposed revisions to Xcel's Fuel Clause Rider tariff (Fuel Clause Rider) to allow pass-through of the costs and revenues associated with the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. Ancillary Services Market, scheduled to commence on January 6, 2009. Along with the revised Fuel Clause Rider tariff, Xcel requests approval of corresponding revisions in the accounting to recover costs and pass through revenues (i.e., credit offsets to the costs) incurred for South Dakota electric customers. The following tariff sheet was filed from Xcel's South Dakota Electric Rate Book – SDPUC No. 2:

Section 5, 3<sup>rd</sup> Revised Sheet No. 64, Cancelling 2<sup>nd</sup> Revised Sheet No. 64

On December 24, 2008, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of January 9, 2009, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention.

At its regularly scheduled February 10, 2009, meeting, the Commission discussed final approval of the application. Commission Staff recommended approval. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the accounting of MISO ASM charges and revenues commencing January 6, 2009, with less than 30 days notice and approved the Fuel Clause Rider tariff allowing pass-through of MISO ASM charges and revenues effective March 1, 2009.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-10 and 49-34A-12. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that the accounting of MiSO ASM charges and revenues commencing January 6, 2009, with less than 30 days notice is hereby approved; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Fuel Clause Rider tariff allowing pass-through of MISO ASM charges and revenues effective March 1, 2009, is hereby approved.
